Bulk liquid carbon dioxide is used in the water treatment process at Moffat. It had been used intermittently in the past to ensure compliance with the EPA's Lead and Copper Rule but through a series of optimization tests it was determined that carbon dioxide is beneficial in the normal course of treatment. This increased its usage and the annual consumption of bulk liquid carbon dioxide warranted the issuance of an invitation for bids.

Requests for bids were sent to ten potential bidders, and faxed to nine SBE organizations, with four responding per the attached bid tabulation. The lowest unit pricing was submitted by Reliant Holdings, Ltd. There was no previous contract for this product, but the low bid is 14% lower than previous unit pricing.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended the Board award Contract No. 12399A to Reliant Holdings, Ltd. for the period September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2011, for a total contract amount of \$190,000.00. This award is based on lowest price and compliance with specifications. Funds are included 2009 Budget and will be included in the 2010 Budget for these expenditures (MPC 4CB0004).
