Tabulation of Bids for High Efficiency Toilets for Low Income and Nonprofit Installations by Others

In an effort to help disadvantaged customers become more efficient in their use of water, Denver Water will be supplying toilets for several retrofit projects in collaboration with the Mile High Youth Corps, Denver Urban Renewal Authority and other nonprofit organizations. Denver Water anticipates that approximately 5,500 toilets will be replaced under this program during 2009 and 2010.

The cost to achieve water savings is approximately \$6,900 per acre-foot when we pay Mile High Youth Corps for the labor.

Requests for bids were sent to eighteen potential bidders. Four responses were received with only one response meeting specifications, per the attached bid tabulation. There were no SBE's available to furnish these plumbing fixtures.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the Board authorize award of Contract No. 12442A to Wholesale Specialties Inc., to furnish high efficiency toilets for the contract period August 1, 2009 through December 31, 2010 for a total contract amount of \$954,250.00. This award is based on lowest price and compliance with specifications. Funds are included in the 2009 Budget and will be included in the 2010 Budget for these expenditures (MPC 4EA0021).
