Purchase of Vehicles for 2012

Information

Each year Denver Water replaces vehicles and heavy equipment in the fleet as determined by a variety of factors including age, mileage, reliability and maintenance costs. Since 1970, Denver Water has participated in the State of Colorado Master Vehicle Contract, which is competitively bid. Denver Water also participates in similar contracts awarded by the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT), and other governmental agencies. These Master Contracts allow state and local governments to gain price advantages inherent in high volume contracts.

This additional purchase includes 18 vehicles (items 1 through 15), the modifications and installations of these vehicles (items 16 through 24), and heavy equipment (items 35 & 37) from government contracts. Items 25 through 38 for heavy equipment reflect the purchase of used equipment less trade in equipment.

Funds for these items have been included in the 2012 Capital Improvement Plan for both vehicles and heavy equipment.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board authorize the purchase of vehicles as follows:


The total contract amount for these additional vehicle purchases is \$968,010.
